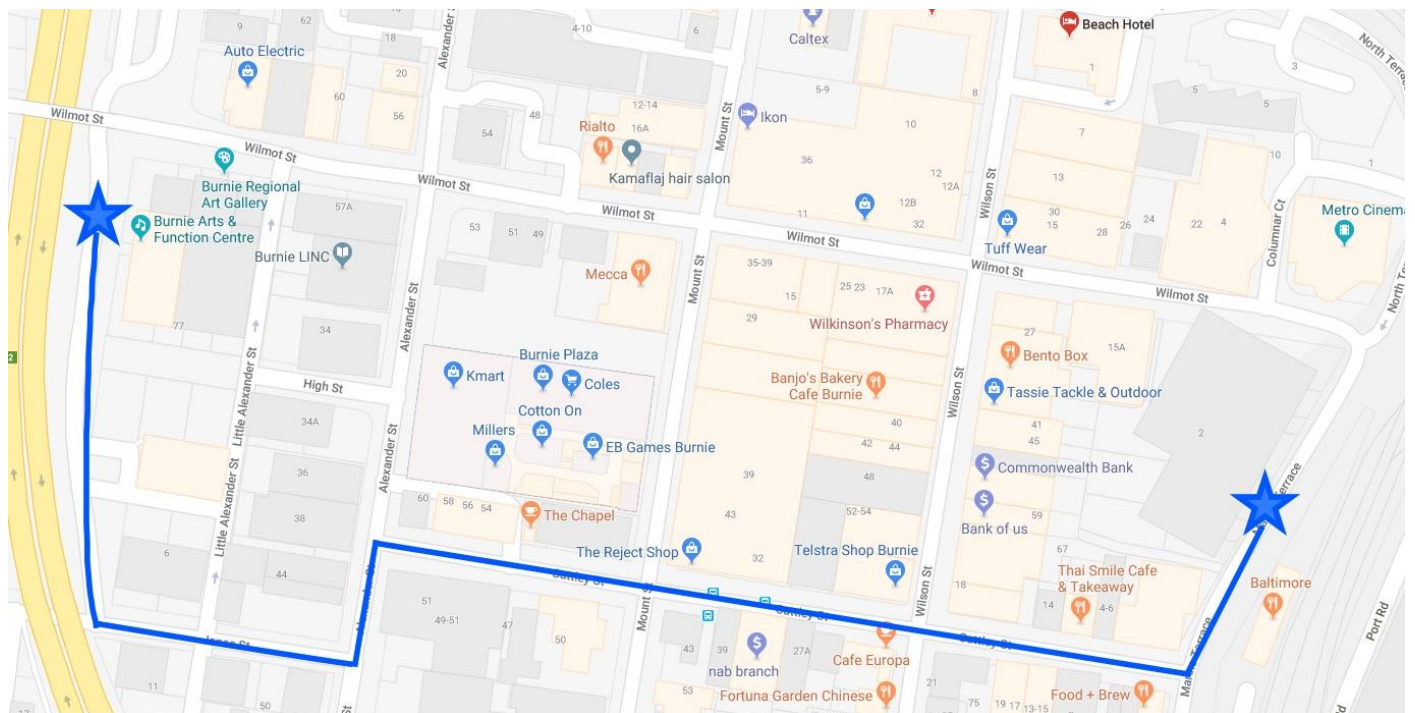

SECTION C | OPERATIONS / COMPETITION

C1: COMPETITOR RELATIONS OFFICERS

Competitor Relations Officers (CROs) have been appointed to support competitors. CROs are the communication between the competitors and the Clerk of Course. Queries from competitors (regarding timing, being held up on a Targa stage, alleged incorrect recording by officials affecting scores, etc.) are handled by the CROs.

To enhance the service to competitors provided by this team there is a telephone number for competitors to contact the CRO's.

C3: RECONNAISSANCE

Reconnaissance notes are available on the Targa website via your competitor console. This will assist competitors in locating the Targa stage start and finish control locations (painted on road surface), and also enable familiarisation with the competition course.

In the past there have been reports from local residents and visitors of excessive speeding of vehicles obviously associated with Targa. Hire cars travelling at high speeds and cutting corners are considered to be obviously Targa North West competitors.

Competitors are advised that if they carry out reconnaissance of the Targa North West course, they must do so at the posted speed limits and abide by all state road rules. It is important that you act in a manner that does not at any time jeopardise the integrity or the public image of Targa events.

Course survey restrictions include:

Limiting the number of multiple runs over the stage at increasing speeds (this will be deemed as practicing).

Restricting course surveys to road-registered vehicles that do not carry any sign-writing relating to Targa North West, Targa High Country or Targa Tasmania.

Any violation of road traffic laws arising from course survey if 'practicing' may lead to competitors being denied permission to compete in the event.

The organisers will not hesitate to take action upon a confirmed report – from the Police or local residents.

C4: TOW TRUCK

A recovery team, including a tow truck, will be available. The purpose of this team is to recover and secure any damaged or un-roadworthy vehicles and ensure the crew is not left stranded at the roadside. The cost of transport back to Burnie is covered by a one off levy. Towing to any other location is the responsibility and cost of the competitor, as is towing by any other contractor other than the Coastal Carriers Towing.

It is NOT the responsibility of the Recovery Team to tow or transport damaged vehicles. They will co-ordinate with the towing contractor, Coastal Carriers Towing to provide accident and breakdown services. Competitors who call for the recovery team must NOT leave their vehicle until the recovery team has arrived, nor should they arrange alternative recovery procedures. Only the Coastal Carrier Towing truck is to be used.

Published towing service rates for Coastal Carriers Towing are as follows:

1. Levy insurance for flat towing to end of section \$120 inc GST
2. Crane recovery is NOT included in levy charge
3. Towing anywhere outside of Burnie will be an extra charge and need to be arranged directly with the towing contractor.
4. Please note that payments by way of cash or card (MasterCard or Visa) only are required.

C5: COMMUNICATIONS

The widespread availability of mobile phones, satellite phones, mobile CB and UHF radios, means that many competitors have their own in-car communication systems.

Whilst Targa North West does not intend to limit these devices, be aware of the following:

Targa North West has a comprehensive communication system linked to a Targa stage safety system, which is designed to respond to any emergency. It is also designed to allow the competition to continue with the minimum possible interruption. Above all it is designed to protect the security of the stage.

When a competitor uses their own in-car communication device to directly call for assistance on a Targa stage (outside the internal Targa North West safety system), they may inadvertently place the stage security at risk. Ambulances, police response vehicles, media, service or support vehicles might potentially enter a stage entirely unknown to event officials and with possible tragic consequences.

In the event of an incident on a Targa stage, either to you or another competitor, or even as a spectator, competitors are required to use the organiser's standard procedures.

Competitors will be issued with a telephone 'hotline' sticker with the number 6221 8825 on it to call to report an accident on a Targa stage direct to the Command Centre. If you need to report an incident, only use this emergency number.

The emergency number will be supplied on a sticker that will be placed on the inside of your windscreen or where clearly visible i.e. near terra trip or on the dashboard.

Note: that a large amount of the course has poor mobile phone coverage.
