SECTION A – ADMINISTRATION

1. AUTHORITY

TARGA Tasmania 30 (hereinafter referred to as the 'event') will be an invitational National TARGA Rally, incorporating international invitees, held under the FIA International Sporting Code including Appendices, the National Competition Rules (hereinafter referred to as NCR) of Motorsport Australia, the Motorsport Australia Tarmac Rally Standing Regulations, the TARGA Technical Regulations 2020 to 2023 Version 3.0, the Motorsport Australia TARGA Championship Sporting Regulations 2020 Version 4.2, the TARGA Tour Regulations 2021 Version 1.0 and these Supplementary Regulations, together with any further regulations or bulletins that may be issued by the organisers, and the route instructions, all of which will have the same force as these regulations. The event consists of six legs of competition commencing in Launceston on 26 April 2022 and finishing in Hobart on 1 May 2022. It will be conducted over approximately 1,900 kilometres and all TARGA stages will be entirely on roads with a bitumen surface. This event will be conducted under and in accordance with Motorsport Australia OH&S and Risk Management Policies, which can be found on the Motorsport Australia website at www.motorsport.org.au. Event Organisers reserve the right to cancel, abandon or postpone the event in accordance with the NCR.

Each competitor/crew member must ensure that they have read and are familiar with the regulations applicable to the event in conjunction with these supplementary regulations.

This Event will be held under the Motorsport Australia Return to Race Strategy.

All competitors and officials are to ensure that they adhere to and observe all necessary COVID-19 Safe practices and directions applicable for the Event.

SECTION B – BRIEFINGS

1. COMPULSORY CREW BRIEFINGS

A. TARGA TOUR BRIEFING

The official briefing for all TARGA Tour participants will be held on Tuesday 26 April at the Hotel Grand Chancellor Launceston at 9.30am. It is compulsory for all TARGA Tour crew members to attend the briefing.

B. COMPETITORS BRIEFING

The official briefing for all competitors will be held on Monday 25 April at the Hotel Grand Chancellor Launceston at 4.30pm. It is compulsory for all competition crew members to attend the briefing.

- Please note that service crews are not required to attend these briefings and won't be given admission.

C. FIRST TIME COMPETITORS BRIEFING - COMPETITIONS ONLY

The official first timers briefing for all first-time competitors (not TARGA Tour) will be held on Tuesday 26 April at the Hotel Grand Chancellor Launceston at 8.30am. It is compulsory for all first-time crew members to attend the briefing.

- Please note that service crews are not required to attend this briefing and won't be given admission.

SECTION C – DOCUMENTATION AND SCRUTINY

1. DOCUMENTATION

Competition documentation will be carried out at the Silverdome, Launceston from 1.00pm to 5.00pm on Saturday 23 April 2022, 12.00pm to 5.00pm on Sunday 24 April 2022 and from 11.00am to 3.00pm on Monday 25 April 2022.

TARGA Tour documentation will be carried out at the Country Club from 11.00am to 5.00pm on Monday 25 April 2022.

2. PRE-START SCRUTINY

Competition vehicles must be presented ready to start with all compulsory equipment on board, including all required apparel at the Silverdome, Launceston from 1.00pm to 5.00pm on Saturday 23 April 2022, 12.00pm to 5.00pm on Sunday 24 April 2022 and from 11.00am to 3.00pm on Monday 25 April 2022.

TARGA Tour scrutiny will be carried out at the Country Club 11.00am to 5.00pm on Monday 25 April 2022.

3. PROTESTS

A protest against any decision of the organisers contained in any class list or start order must be lodged within one hour of the posting of the list. Postings on the Official Notice Board will be as follows:

SECTION D - AWARDS

1. GENERAL

All awards will be presented to the nominated drivers and navigators unless otherwise specified in the details of awards. It is a condition of receiving an award that the driver and navigator (or their nominee) is present at the Presentation Dinner, unless prior advice of inability to attend has been given to and accepted by the Competitors Manager.

D) GEORGE TOWN SUPER STREET STAGE AWARDS

Trophies will be presented to the fastest vehicle in Thoroughbred Trophy, GT Sports Trophy and each category (2 to 9), as well as the overall fastest car through the stage. Trophies will be presented at the presentation dinner on 2 May 2022 at the Hotel Grand Chancellor Hobart.

2. TOURIST TROPHY - TARGA TOUR

Will be presented to the driver and co-driver of each crew who has completed each and every TARGA stage.

SPEED LIMITED AWARDS

3. TARGA TROPHY - TSD TROPHY

- a) A TARGA Trophy will be presented to the driver and co-driver or navigator of each crew who has completed each and every TARGA stage and scored fewer than 850 total penalty points.
- b) A Golden TARGA Trophy will be presented to any competitor (driver, co-driver or navigator) who satisfies the requirements for a TARGA trophy in three successive years of the event. The Golden TARGA Trophy will be presented in lieu of the normal TARGA trophy award.
- c) A competitor winning a fourth consecutive TARGA trophy will be awarded a normal TARGA trophy (not another Golden TARGA Trophy) and starts on the cycle towards winning a Platinum TARGA Trophy.
- d) A Platinum TARGA Trophy will be presented to any competitor who has already won a Golden TARGA Trophy, and since winning that trophy, has again satisfied the requirements for a TARGA trophy in three successive years. The Platinum TARGA Trophy will be presented in lieu of the normal TARGA trophy award. A Platinum Trophy can be won in two separate groups of three. It is not necessary to achieve six successive TARGA trophies.

4. TARGA TROPHY - THOROUGHBRED & GT SPORTS TROPHY

- a) A TARGA Trophy will be presented to the driver and co-driver or navigator of each crew who has completed each and every TARGA stage within the trophy time specified in the road books for Thoroughbred Trophy & GT Sports Trophy.
- b) A Golden TARGA Trophy will be presented to any competitor (driver, co-driver or navigator) who satisfies the requirements for a TARGA trophy in three successive years of the event. The Golden TARGA Trophy will be presented in lieu of the normal TARGA trophy award.
- c) A competitor winning a fourth consecutive TARGA trophy will be awarded a normal TARGA trophy (not another Golden TARGA Trophy) and starts on the cycle towards winning a Platinum TARGA Trophy.
- d) A Platinum TARGA Trophy will be presented to any competitor who has already won a Golden TARGA Trophy, and since winning that trophy, has again satisfied the requirements for a TARGA trophy in three successive years. The Platinum TARGA Trophy will be presented in lieu of the normal TARGA trophy award. A Platinum Trophy can be won in two separate groups of three. It is not necessary to achieve six successive TARGA trophies.

5. TARGA PLATES WON IN SPEED LIMITED COMPETITIONS

Competitors can move between TSD, Thoroughbred and GT Sports Trophy to achieve successive plate wins in the same way as full competitions can but TARGA Plates won in any speed limited trophy competition cannot be used or added to in order to achieve any plates won in any of the full competitions or vice versa. Without exception, TARGA Plates won in speed limited competition will be recorded separately to those won in full competitions.

FULL COMPETITION AWARDS

6. TARGA TROPHIES

- a) A TARGA Trophy will be presented to the driver and co-driver or navigator of each crew who has completed each and every TARGA stage within the trophy time specified in the road book for their vehicle class.
- b) A Golden TARGA Trophy will be presented to any competitor (driver, co-driver or navigator) who satisfies the requirements for a TARGA trophy in three successive years of the event. The Golden TARGA Trophy will be presented in lieu of the normal TARGA trophy award.
- c) A competitor winning a fourth consecutive TARGA trophy will be awarded a normal TARGA trophy (not another Golden TARGA Trophy) and starts on the cycle towards winning a Platinum TARGA Trophy.
- d) A Platinum TARGA Trophy will be presented to any competitor who has already won a Golden TARGA Trophy, and since winning that trophy, has again satisfied the requirements for a TARGA trophy in three successive years. The Platinum TARGA Trophy will be presented in lieu of the normal TARGA trophy award. A Platinum Trophy can be won in two separate groups of three. It is not necessary to achieve six successive TARGA trophies.
- e) A Diamond TARGA Trophy will be presented to any competitor who has already won a Platinum TARGA Trophy, and since winning that trophy, has again satisfied the requirements for a TARGA trophy in three successive years. A Diamond Trophy can be won in three separate groups of three. It is not necessary to achieve nine successive TARGA trophies
- f) A Golden Diamond TARGA Trophy will be presented to any competitor who has already won a Diamond TARGA Trophy, and since winning that trophy, has again satisfied the requirements for a TARGA trophy in three successive years. A Golden Diamond Trophy can be won in four separate groups of three. It is not necessary to achieve twelve successive TARGA trophies
- g) A Platinum Diamond TARGA Trophy will be presented to any competitor who has already won a Golden Diamond TARGA Trophy, and since winning that trophy, has again satisfied the requirements for a TARGA trophy in three successive years. Upon receipt of a Platinum Diamond TARGA Trophy the competitor will be inducted into the TARGA Tasmania Hall of Fame TARGA Legends Section at the Presentation Dinner at the Hotel Grand Chancellor. A Platinum Diamond Trophy can be won in five separate groups of three. It is not necessary to achieve fifteen successive TARGA trophies

7. TARGA PLATES WON IN FULL COMPETITIONS

TARGA Plates won in any full competition cannot be used or added to in order to achieve any plates won in any of the speed limited competitions or vice versa. Without exception, TARGA Plates won in full competition will be recorded separately to those won in speed limited competitions.

8. JOHN LARGE 15 YEAR COMPETITOR MEMORIAL AWARD

Awarded to those competitors who have competed in 15 years of TARGA Tasmania in memory of John Large, the founder of TARGA Tasmania who passed away in May 2006 during the 15th anniversary event. In receiving the John Large Memorial Award, the competitor will be inducted into the TARGA Tasmania Hall of Fame at the Presentation Dinner on Monday 2 May 2022 at the Hotel Grand Chancellor.

9. FINISHERS MEDALLION

Finishers Medallions will be presented to competitors/participants when the competing vehicle, or parts thereof, crosses the official finish line of the event in Hobart on Sunday 1 May 2022 before the commencement of the Champagne Shower presentations.

10. AWARD PRESENTATION DINNER

The Presentation Dinner will be held on Monday 2 May at the Hotel Grand Chancellor in Hobart commencing at 7.00pm. All competitions, George Town Street Stage, Golden, Platinum, Diamond, Golden Diamond, Platinum Diamond Trophies & Hall of Fame Legends Induction, John Large 15 Year Competitor Award & Hall of Fame Induction, 20 Year Competitor Award, 25 Year Competitor Award, 30 Year Competitor Award and all Motorsport Australia TARGA Championship winners will be announced and presented with their awards.

11. TROPHY COLLECTION

It is a requirement for a recipient of any TARGA trophy that the crew must attend the Presentation dinner held on Monday 2 May at Hotel Grand Chancellor Hobart or must attend trophy collection on Monday 2 May from 10.00am to 1.00pm also at the Hotel Grand Chancellor Hobart. If unable to attend and the trophies are uncollected, crews will be responsible and required to pay for the cost of shipping the trophies to the drivers address as supplied to TARGA.

SECTION E - TERMS AND CONDITIONS FOR THE INVITATION PROCESS

Applications for Invitations to Compete in TARGA Tasmania 2022 close at 5.00pm on Friday 25 March 2022.

1. APPLICATION, WITHDRAWAL AND REFUNDS

Applications are to be lodged with TARGA via the Motorsport Australia entry console on the TARGA website; specifying the vehicle in which the applicant has nominated to compete; listing the exact year the vehicle was built, and be accompanied by an **application fee of AUD\$500 inc GST, which is non-refundable or non-transferrable**. An applicant who applies to compete and who then withdraws up to seven days before the start of the event will receive a refund of all monies paid less the application fee of AUD\$500 including GST. Any withdrawal within seven days before the start of the event will not be entitled to a refund at the sole discretion of TARGA. Applications may be submitted after the close of applications date at the discretion of TARGA.

2. INVITATION TO COMPETE/PARTICIPATE

An Invitation to Compete is issued by TARGA at their sole discretion. Any such invitation applies only to the nominated entrant, the nominated driver and the nominated vehicle as shown in the application. An entrant wishing to change the vehicle originally nominated after an invitation to compete has been issued, must notify TARGA who, at their sole discretion, reserve the right to withdraw the original invitation and consider the proposed replacement vehicle as a new application. TARGA reserves the right to decline an Invitation to Compete in an event without giving a reason. An entrant invited to compete will be notified of our decision to issue an invitation. If any outstanding entry fee/s are not received in full by the Close of Entries date, TARGA reserve the right to withdraw the invitation and allocate the vehicle competition number to another invited applicant. TARGA owns all vehicle competition numbers and reserves the right to allocate any number to who it decides and can change any competitors allocated competition number without giving a reason.

Subject to the approval of Motorsport Australia issuing the permit to conduct the event, it is a condition of entry that from the completion of each vehicle's pre-event self- scrutiny form and pre-event tyre-marking, the vehicle is subject to Security Park conditions as set down in the TARGA Sporting Regulations. It is also a condition of the invitation that it is acknowledged that a \$10,000 excess is in place for all property damage caused by competitors and tour participants at all TARGA events. 3. EVENT CANCELLATION & NON-ATTENDANCE

In the instance of an event cancellation due to decisions made by authorities beyond the control of TARGA, for whatever reason, all entrants will receive a **full transfer without penalty** to the next running of the cancelled TARGA event, which if the competitor cannot attend, the process as outlined in 1. will apply. Entry fees cannot be transferred to any other TARGA events.

In the instance of an entrant not being able to attend due to decisions made by authorities beyond their control, such as a border closure or quarantine requirements, these entrants will, at the discretion of TARGA, receive a **full refund without penalty**. Entry fees cannot be transferred to any TARGA events.

4. COPYRIGHT

The entrant agrees all photography, video and film rights for the event is the property of TARGA. Competitors are permitted to carry video cameras in their vehicles for the purpose of making moving or still picture records for their private viewing, but TARGA retain copyright of all photographic and/or film/video footage associated with the event. No movie, film or video taping of any part of the event shall be carried out by entrant or crew member other than with the express approval, in writing, of TARGA. Any commercial arrangements made by the entrants and crew members for the sale of film or video/still footage, or viewing of such footage in a public place, must be approved in writing by TARGA. Entrants and crew members are advised to contact TARGA prior to making commitments for any such commercial arrangement.

The entrant agrees all data obtained by the RallySafe device for the event is the property of TARGA and competitors can only obtain and use this data with the written permission of TARGA. Failure to observe these regulations may lead to legal action by TARGA for a breach of copyright. All crew members agree to the use in perpetuity of their names and photographs, and photographs of their vehicles, in publicity material issued by TARGA or the event sponsors and to comply with the film and video regulations.

All crew members agree that their names and contact details may be made available to and be used by sponsors and licensees of the event. TARGA have the right in perpetuity to authorise the production, distribution and sale of models, photographs or other forms of reproduction of any vehicle participating in the event, in competition livery (including drivers, co-drivers and navigator names) for event-related promotions.

By signing up for a TARGA event, you agree to subscribe to newsletters, marketing or promotional materials and other information TARGA may send. However, you may opt out of receiving any, or all, of these communications from us by following the unsubscribe link on any TARGA promotional correspondence.

5. ADDITIONAL FEES

TARGA reserve the right to charge additional fees as required for third party providers. These fees will be listed on the website no less than 30 days before the commencement of the event.

6. ADDITIONAL CREW MEMBERS

Additional crew members may be nominated as replacements before or during the event, but the nomination must be submitted using the correct form. Acceptance of the nomination will be at the discretion of TARGA. A fee of AUD\$1,000 including GST will apply for each additional person nominated for each vehicle.

7. ENTRY FEES

All entry fees must be paid by Friday 25 March 2022. If any entry fee is not received in full by 25 March 2022 the organisers reserve the right to withdraw the invitation and allocate the vehicle competition number to another invited applicant.
